> Designed by Mary Dorrington Ward and Pat Doyle, Paperweight Desk is the first in a series of products due for release this year by Cardboard Future. Made from 80 per cent recycled paper, the cardboard desk complies with European legislation on strength and stability. It comes with full cable management with power and data accessed by clutter-busting desktop panels. The legs are fully adjustable and there's the option of adding an extra cardboard storage unit under the desk. No screws, staples, glue or tools are required to make Paperweight and, if you're worried that a spilt coffee might result in some sort of meltdown, don't be - the corrugated board is coated in a water-resistant cellulose varnish.
